


About us

Extended over **60 hectares**, comprising a golf course an eighteen-hole golf course, two tennis courts, a restaurant and an outdoor swimming pool.










New Campus

The **new campus** is organised with innovative and interactive spaces and extends over **11 floors for** a **total of 24,000 square metres**.

The aim is to open it up to exchanges of experience and to an educational world that demands more and more multimedia. Not only classrooms and laboratories, but also the creation of environments designed for discussion and sharing.

The project involves maintaining the original design of the building by architect Aldo Rossi with structural elements that recall the traditions and culture of the area.

PhD in Economics and Management of Sustainability and Innovation (EMSI)

The PhD in Economics and Management of Sustainability and Innovation is a 3 year English taught international program, is designed for highly qualified and motivated students who wish to acquire research and analytical skills in business and management disciplines related to sustainability and innovation management. The course provides students with a solid methodological basis and the ability to design and implement research projects in economics and business disciplines, with particular attention to sustainability (e.g. social innovation, technological innovation, innovative business models).

PhD in General Process Theory (GPT)

The PhD in General Process Theory is a three year program taught in Italian and offers a training course that is characterized by its interdisciplinary nature, aimed at investigating and studying the procedural institution in its multifaceted discipline in the various sectors of the Italian legal system.

This research path, therefore, will constantly start from an original cultural background as the result of that comparative unitary approach which constitutes the distinctive feature of this doctorate, together with the comparison with some foreign universities for the purpose of verifying and comparing the procedural system Italian with other foreign systems.






The LUM School of Management is the point of reference for post graduates.

In addition to the traditional Master's degree and Advanced Training and Specialisation courses, the School supports important activities of high scientific value: it promotes numerous seminar initiatives and important conferences, it establishes and realises 'Summer Schools', occasions for meetings and debates on corporate innovation processes, participates in the realisation of experimental and research initiatives with the main public and private territorial players.

In this development process, numerous fruitful relationships are gradually being consolidated with companies, public with enterprises, public institutions and healthcare companies, third sector organisations and with representative organisations, for which the School is a privileged interlocutor, aimed at offering skills and resources, to collaborate with the productive, institutional and cultural fabric.





Visiting

LUM has established a structured programme to invite visiting professors to spend one or two semesters on campus.

Visiting Professorships can also be arranged for shorter periods (the minimum period is of one month) and are awarded to interested candidates according to the Visiting Scientists guidelines available on the website.

Marco Polo / Turandot

Marco Polo project is designed to facilitate the enrolment of Chinese students at Italian universities.

Every year LUM University reserves a number of places for Marco Polo students and provides **10-month Italian language courses** for both Marco Polo and Turandot students.

At LUM is also available a **Chinese desk** to help Chinese students to deal with the cultural shock and adapt to the Italian culture.

Italian for foreigners Program

This year-round program provides Italian language and academic preparation for international students who want to improve their Italian for university admission or carrier advancement.
