


About us



Casamassima is a **charming town located in the metropolitan city of Bari**, in the Puglia region of southern Italy. Situated about 20 kilometers (12 miles) southeast of Bari, Casamassima is part of the hilly inland area known as the Murgia. The town has approximately 20,000 inhabitants, making it a moderately sized community in the region.

Casamassima has ancient origins, with evidence of settlements dating back to the Neolithic period. The town's name is believed to derive from "Casa Maxima" (large house), possibly referring to an important Roman villa in the area. The historic center, known as "The Blue City", is characterized by whitewashed buildings with blue-painted doors, windows, and balconies. This unique feature dates back to a cholera epidemic in the 17th century when the town was spared, allegedly due to the intercession of the Virgin Mary.

The town is well-positioned for exploring other notable sites in Puglia, including the trulli of Alberobello, the seaside town of Polignano a Mare, and the baroque city of Lecce.



LUM University is in the surrounding of **Bari**, the capital of Italy's Puglia region, a vibrant coastal city on the Adriatic Sea. As a foreign student, **you'll find Bari offers a unique blend of history, culture, and modern urban life**. The city is divided into the atmospheric old town, Bari Vecchia, with its maze-like streets and historic buildings, and the more orderly new town, featuring wide boulevards and shopping districts. Bari is renowned for its delicious cuisine, including orecchiette pasta and focaccia barese. The city's warm Mediterranean climate and beautiful beaches make it an attractive destination year-round. The city's strategic location also makes it an ideal base for exploring other parts of Puglia, such as the trulli of Alberobello or the white city of Ostuni. With its rich cultural heritage, friendly locals, and lower cost of living compared to northern Italian cities, Bari offers an authentic Italian experience for international students.



New Campus

The **new campus** is organised with innovative and interactive spaces and extends over **11 floors for a total of 24,000 square metres.**

The aim is to open it up to exchanges of experience and to an educational world that demands more and more multimedia. Not only classrooms and laboratories, but also the creation of environments designed for discussion and sharing.

The project involves maintaining the original design of the building by the architect Aldo Rossi with structural elements that recall the traditions and culture of the area.



PhD in Economics and Management of Sustainability and Innovation (EMSI)

The PhD in Economics and Management of Sustainability and Innovation is a 3 year English taught international program, designed for highly qualified and motivated students who wish to acquire research and analytical skills in business and management disciplines related to sustainability and innovation management. The course provides students with a solid methodological basis and the ability to design and implement research projects in economics and business disciplines, with particular attention to sustainability (e.g. social innovation, technological innovation, innovative business models).

PhD in General Process Theory (GPT)






SCHOOL OF MANAGEMENT

UNIVERSITÀ LUM

Our School of Management offers a comprehensive portfolio of **postgraduate programs** designed to develop the next generation of business leaders and management professionals. The school provides **Executive Education programs, including an Executive MBA and short-term certificate courses**, tailored for working professionals seeking to enhance their skills while maintaining their careers. Visiting

LUM has established a structured **programme to invite visiting professors to spend one or two semesters on campus.**

Visiting Professorships can also be arranged for shorter periods (the minimum period is one month) and are awarded to interested candidates according to the Visiting Scientists guidelines available on the website.

Foundation Course

The Foundation Course is an **introductory and preparatory course taught in Italian** designed for students who aim to attend university in Italy.

The course targets students who do not meet the 12-year schooling requirement, or other specific requirements, necessary to access a university program in Italy. But it is also suitable for students who want to learn or improve their Italian language proficiency.

The Foundation Program offers:

- a 300-hour Italian language & culture course (October-August);
- a 300-hour of discipline-specific courses, taught in English, based on the study track selected by the student between
 - Economic & Legal Area or
 - Scientific & Technological Area.

To enroll, students need:

- A final **high school diploma** released upon completion of at least **11 years of schooling**, accompanied by transcripts.
- Turning 18 by the end of the program (June 30). A legal tutor is required for minors.

Italian for foreigners Program

The School of Italian for Foreigners at LUM University offers **comprehensive courses in the Italian language designed for international students and non-native speakers.**

These programs cater to learners at various proficiency levels, from complete beginners to advanced speakers looking to refine their skills.

Key features of the school typically include:

- **Diverse course offerings:** Classes range from intensive immersion programs to part-time evening courses, accommodating different schedules and learning goals.
- **Qualified instructors:** Native Italian speakers with expertise in teaching Italian as a foreign language lead the courses.
- Cultural immersion: Many schools incorporate Italian culture, history, and customs into their curriculum to provide a well-rounded learning experience.
- Small class sizes: This ensures personalized attention and ample opportunity for students to practice speaking.
- Modern teaching methods: Schools often use interactive technologies and communicative approaches to enhance language acquisition.
- **Preparation for language certifications:** Courses may help students prepare for recognized Italian language proficiency tests like CILS or PLIDA.
- **Extracurricular activities:** Language exchange programs, cultural excursions, and social events may be offered to supplement classroom learning.
- Flexible enrollment: Students can often choose short-term or long-term study options to suit their needs.



Marco Polo/Turandot

The Marco Polo/Turandot Program is a 11-month preparatory course tailored for Chinese students wishing to enroll in Italian universities. This comprehensive program includes an intensive Italian language course, covering grammar, phonetics, and speaking, alongside a course on Italian culture and a specialized test preparation module.

With a focus on **practical communication skills**, the program equips **Chinese students with a solid foundation in Italian language and culture**, ensuring they are well-prepared for academic success in Italy.

In order to be admitted to the program, students **must have** a **Chinese secondary school leaving certificate with a duration of 12 years of schooling and a "Gao Kao" exam score of at least 400/750 or equivalent**, in line with the indications provided by the Italian Diplomatic Representation in China.

For students from Hong Kong and Macao, not subject to the Gao Kao exam system, the study documentation must be evaluated by the university and the competent Italian consular authority, in order to verify the requirements useful for entry to courses of study in Italy.

Erasmus+ Program

Erasmus+ is the European Union's flagship program for education, training, youth, and sport, offering a wide range of opportunities for individuals and organizations across Europe and beyond. At its core, Erasmus+ supports the mobility of students, staff, and learners through scholarships and exchanges, allowing them to study, train, or gain work experience in another country. LUM has a network of international student mobility agreements of more than 150 foreign universities.
